Willy's Story

Wilson is 22 years old, and an orphan. He grew up with his mother and grandmother in great deprivation and poverty. After his mother died there were times when Wilson seriously considered committing suicide, but Christian friends helped him with food, school fees and encouragement, and he pulled through.

After finishing Senior 6 he worked on a farm digging and looking after the animals for 15 months, to raise money for a course in Air Cargo Handling. He thought the money would be enough, but with all the extras for books, registration and examination fees etc., he now realises that he doesn't have enough money to complete the course. He has just three terms left to do.
